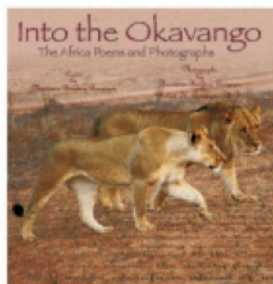

Into the Okavango: The Africa Poems and Photographs

Into the Okavango is an exquisite compilation of more than 500 photographs and beautiful poetry, taking readers on a journey through several of the most untamed territories Africa has to offer. Photographers Marianne Harding Burgoyne and Dr. Robert H. Burgoyne, a husband-and-wife team, travel through Botswana, Zimbabwe, and South Africa, staying at camps and national parks such as the Savuti, Khwai, Chobe, and Hwang. They explore endless mazes of waterways and visit exotic, powerful places, including Victoria Falls and Lake Kariba. The history of many wild animals is captured in pictures and artfully composed poems, which are presented along with information on their habitat, hunting and mating habits, and interactions with humans who venture into their natural environment.

Harding Burgoyne's personal history gives readers a feel for her deep love of animals. She also has received the Utah Psychiatric Association's Annual Media Award for promoting public awareness of mental-health issues. She and her husband, a renowned psychiatric specialist, published *Shakespeare and the Genetics of Being* and several other works.

A stunning picture of two lions graces the cover of the generously oversized, 12-by-13-inch publication. The incredible close-ups of wildlife make *Into the Okavango* a fascinating, perfect gift. Your customers will be as wowed as I am!
